



PICKLEBALL Drop-In Guidelines

The purpose of our Drop-In Program is to provide the opportunity to meet new people and mix up play when possible. When Drop-In play is scheduled and all courts are full, it is required that players take turns to allow everyone to play.

Drop-In Play is scheduled on 4 courts. **We do not currently assign courts by level, but we will have one court designated for beginners.** The best way to improve your game is to play against the same level players, so we will help you find the right court(s) to play on.

Drop-In Guidelines

When players are waiting to play, and courts are full

1. Four players will play a game to eleven points and then vacate the court they just played
2. Four new players will then use the vacated court and continue the process
3. Players waiting should line up paddles in a group of four by the net to determine who is next to play.
4. All players waiting to play should be ready to enter the courts as a group.
5. Please remember to ask for permission if passing through another court being used and thank the players while passing.

When players ARE NOT waiting to play and there are empty courts available.

6. Four players will play a game to eleven points.
7. If no other players are waiting to play, the same four players may continue to play another game. **Important:** If new waiting players are present, the waiting players have priority for court access.

Please remember, for your own safety, no running shoes are allowed. Proper tennis attire is required, thank you.
